



Suffering ~ Life's Mandatory Lesson Albert Cheng

Introduction: The ups and downs of life

- 1. Suffering is a lesson that is difficult to learn
 - > For Christians, it is not an elective but a compulsory course.
 - Although God will discipline his people, it is not God's final intention to bring suffering.
- 2. Life is full of hardships and uncertainties
 - > Suffering is often not chosen by people, nor is it comprehensible to people.
- 3. I am afraid that there are not any Christians who have not experienced trials and tribulations!
 - The crises and storms in life are not a question of presence or absence, but a question of time!
- 4. In the storm, God will lead you across; the storm by Christ is showing you the direction
 - The rainbow is seen after the storm; life grows in adversity
 - I have difficulties and God opens a path; God's grace manifested through suffering (Romans 8:28)
- 5. [Misery] is often associated with <lost> Losing....relatives and friends, property, job, love, health
- Every <lose> brings a <choice>.
 Choice to allow the <lose> take you down anger, blame, hatred, frustration and resentment;

Choice to let <lose> take you down a new, wider and deeper road.

- 7. [Troubles will never come, God will protect?] Psalm 91
 - We can ask God to grant us all the blessings in this life, to deliver us from every trouble, to protect us from many dangers,
 - But you have to trust God to such an extent that even if there is nothing good given to you form this world, and the disasters of this life come one after another, you still believe in God and know that there is eternal blessing in God.

1. [The source of suffering]

- 1. Suffering can be the penalty for sin
 - > Genesis 3 states that man sinned leading to death and suffering
 - Women have to go through the pain of childbirth, and men have to work hard all their lives to make ends meet
- 2. Suffering can be an instrument of discipline.
 - ➢ God uses suffering to discipline those He loves. (Hebrews 12:6-10)
 - Our Heavenly Father does not like to see us suffer, yet He disciplines us for our good as a father disciplines his children.
 - It helps God's loved ones to resist evil, and makes us partakers of His holiness. (Hebrews12:19)
- 3. Suffering can result from persecution by others
- 4. Suffering can be Satan's attack (Job 1/2)
- 5. Suffering can be for the glory of God: Some sufferings have nothing to do with sin

(John 9:3)

2. [Why does God allow suffering?]

In the midst of our misery, we are bewildered, as if looking at the reverse side of an embroidery: not seeing the ingenious design of the embroiderer!

- 1. To " warn" us
 - Pain = signal alert = something goes wrong fire/hammer/broken bone/cardiac arrest
- 2. To "guide" us Joni [paralyzed in diving accident]
 - Realizing that our own abilities are limited forces us to review the direction of our lives
- 3. To " shape" us (Romans 5:3-4).
 - Suffering reveals how *spiritual* people are
 - > There will be no " achievement " without " hardship ".

If an olive is not pressed into pulp, it cannot be made into oil.

If the grapes are not in the winepress, they cannot be made into wine.

If the husk of the wheat is not broken, it cannot produce many grains.

If Mary had not broken the alabaster vase, the ointment would not have been fragrant.

If Joseph is not sold into Egypt, everyone will die in famine.

If Jesus hadn't gone to the cross, we would still be living in sin today.

Lord, shall I be wounded by Your permission? Every blow is a real benefit, if what you take away, you replace with yourself.

3. [Why do the righteous suffer?]

1. Where is God when suffering occurs? Why? (Psalm 22:1-3)

Because there is only one true God to believe in! Because I believe that God is Almighty! Because I believe that God is merciful!

2. Don't misunderstand God's heart, he does not intend to make you suffer and sorrow (Lamentations 3:31-33) After these things, there will be love and compassion beyond your expectation.

- The fact that the righteous suffer more is not because God is unjust or not loving enough, but because God has a special plan for their lives. Psalm 34:19
- The sufferings of the righteous have been measured by God, and God knows how much the righteous can bear! God allows suffering to befall us because of His respect and trust in us!
- He believes that we will be able to overcome suffering, and our faith will not be deteriorated because of suffering. 1 Corinthians 10:13
- Let us bravely stand firmly on the Lord in the midst of suffering, and finally share the glory with Him!

3. Nothing that Satan does could happen without God's permission. Example: Job's life

4. Heavenly Father allows suffering to happen, but also promises grace to come; the suffering we have suffered can be comforted in the arms of Heavenly Father, and it can become a blessing, bringing peace to those around you.

4. [What does the Bible say about suffering?]

1 Peter 2:21 To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps.

1 Peter 4: 9~10 Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling. Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

1 Peter 4:12,13 Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice inasmuch as you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed.

John 16:33 "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.'

Psalm 34:19 The righteous person may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all.

Psalm 119:71 It was good for me to be afflicted, so that I might learn your decrees.

5. [5 Benefits of Suffering for Christians]

- 1. Suffering causes us to discover that we cannot control things and to trust in Him who is in control
 - Comfort easily makes people trust in themselves; they do not entrust the sovereignty of life to God.
 - Everything should not be taken for granted, it is all of God's grace that everything goes on smoothly
- 2. Suffering allows [love] find the best [manifestation]
 - Suffering is a crucial opportunity to allow people who have no relationship with each other become interrelated.
- 3. Suffering reorients man toward things of eternal value and weakens his attachment to the world.
 - The abundance of material life makes us love the world; we cannot love God and love the world.
- 4. Suffering makes faith more precious; [a place of affliction] is a [school of faith] established by God.
 - Suffering is an "opportunity" to examine faith seriously. Faith is based on God? Or in God-given things?
 - > God-given faith is true and will not be lost. Though it is painful, God is still in control
 - Have faith to keep your inner peace and security, because "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail." (Lamentations 3:22).
- 5. Suffering makes us more like Christ.
 - Adversity Reveals Our *Old Self*: Ignore the old self and keep grooming up? Open yourself up and let God build and mold!

6. [When problems/difficulties strike...]

- 1. Don't ask "Why?"
 - "God, why? Why me? Why is it me that there are so many people in this world?"
 - We start to question God's love for us: We ask God, "Why, God? If You loved me, You wouldn't let me suffer, would you?"

- As we seek God in prayer and wait for His answer, we slowly feel that we have no reason to suffer and begin to resent Him.
- 2. To ask "what"?
 - > Ask, "What exactly does God want me to learn about this?"
 - > Or "What lessons can I learn so that this difficulty never happens again?"
 - When we turn our problems over to God, He uses us and others to change our circumstances.
 - However, if God does not change our circumstances, then He will change our perspective on the matter and give us love, joy, peace, and wisdom.
- 3. To ask "how"?
 - Ask, "How can I glorify God in this experience? How can I learn the most from my environment?
 - Asking God will help us determine how we handle things. We begin to work with God in the problems we face, seeing things from His perspective.
 - God has promised us in his word that he will never forsake or forsake us. Walking in God's footsteps during tough times is also a way to help us build our faith and character.

[Conclusion] Footprints on the beach

- 1. God is not the creator of suffering; God is the end of suffering and evil
 - Suffering will pass, and it will eventually be eliminated. " weeping may stay for the night, but rejoicing comes in the morning. "
 - *tears* and *emotions* are God-given [relief] for our spiritual release
 - He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain (Revelation 21:4)
- 2. [Endure hardship] is like [Eating supplements], [Learning] is equal to [Earnning]

3. Suffering and God's love are not in conflict. No one can separate us from the love of Christ. (Romans 8:35)

4. Suffering is [wrapping paper], blessing is [gift]

The things we encounter in life, the environment seems to be cursed, it seems to be difficult, but when we look back, we find that it is God's blessing.

5. God can calm the storm around you, but more often than not, God chooses to keep your peace of mind.

6. God knows what is best for us! Although his method of helping us is not necessarily what we expect and requested!

7. First <surrender> to the Lord, then <calmly be assured> to thank the Lord

8. Beautiful life is shaped from difficult circumstances!

[Group Discussion Questions]

- 1. Personal Thoughts: Please share an important takeaway from this message that you should keep in mind. According to your current situation, which point is most important to you? Please share.
- 2. Have you learned the lesson of suffering well? In suffering, what has God taught you?
- 3. *Suffering is a blessing in disguise * Can you share your personal life experience?

Prepare Yourself To Meet God

Bible Verse : Matthew 25:1-13

Introduction:

- 1. Jesus spoke a parable about how children of God should prepare themselves to meet God. Jesus added, "Be on your guard, for you do not know the day or the hour."
- 2. As a conclusion to express that life on earth is temporal and short, we should cherish, make good use of plan and prepare ourselves with wisdom to meet God.
- 3. So my theme is: "Prepare yourself to meet God," and let's explore the parable together in three ways.

A. The first reminder of this parable is the end of life

- 1. Every life comes to an end and faces God.
 - Knowing this fact, we should cherish and plan our life properly.
 - We have to remind ourselves that one day life will end and see our God.
- 2. We will see God when we die.
 - Heb 9:27 Every man is destined to die, and that after death there will be judgment. This tells us very clearly that whether you like it or not, you and I will one day end our lives in death.
 - And face the judgment of God after death, do we have such vigilance?
 - The parable of the ten virgins reminds us of the fact that we will one day see God.
- 3. We must face Jesus when he returns for the second time.
 - When Jesus was resurrected and ascended into heaven, the angel said to the crowd, " This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven." (Acts 1:11)
 - But when the Lord Jesus will return, no one knows at all.
 - But one day He will surely come again.
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:2 "For you know very well that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night."
 - Matt24:44 "So you also must be ready, because the Son of Man will come at an hour when you do not expect him."

B. The second reminder of this parable: life is temporal and short

- 1. We should be "ready" to meet God
- Since life is so fickle and short, we should always be prepared to see God at all times.
- So what to prepare? We can be reminded of the virgins lighting the lamps and preparing the oil.
- 2. To light your lamp
- Jesus reminds us in this parable that we must light our lamp so that it will shine.
- The light in the Bible refers to the good works of man.

- The Lord said, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father who is in heaven."
- 3. To be able to continue to shine the light
- To meet this requirement, it is necessary to
 - 1. bring enough oil
 - 2. Know how to trim the wick.
- Obedience to the inspiration and pruning of the Holy Spirit in the heart will bear forth the fruit of the Holy Spirit.
- Even if it is weak at times, failure is like the time when five wise virgins doze off.
- As the oil is prepared, even if the light is weak, once some oil is added, it will definitely emit light again.

C. The third reminder of this parable: prepare your own spiritual life

- 3.1 This parable reminds us that there is no substitute for faith
- Speaking directly, faith is something you have to accept and experience.
- We need to have a personal relationship with God, and our parents cannot replace us.
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3.2 Believing is present tense not future tense

- The five foolish virgins went out to buy oil and came back too late to see the bridegroom.
- This reminds us that we should prepare well in our daily life, otherwise it will be too late to meet the Lord.
- Because some things cannot be done at the last minute.

Conclusion:

- 1. The first parable reminds us that our lives come to an end, whether we want to or not.
- 2. The second parable reminds us that we should be prepared to meet God, and that we must act with integrity.
- 3. The third parable: Prepare to meet God with a mature and healthy spiritual life.

- 1. How do we prepare ourselves to meet God?
- 2. From this message what are the 3 reminders to illuminate us? Please elaborate.
- 3. What can we learn from the ten virgins?
