6. Beware of cults/heretics

Recently, we know that cults/heretics organizations have infiltrated the church and frequently invited brothers and sisters to participate in their activities. Meanwhile, we also observed their following practices and reactions:

- 1. Recruit believers to participate in various Bible courses through various means of making friends and chatting on social media.
- 2. When asking the other party about their basic Christian beliefs, they may appear mysterious and unwilling to listen or respond.
- 3. Visit new friends in the church, show exceptional enthusiasm, ask for contact information from members, but remain mysterious, constantly lobbying members to participate in Bible classes or other gatherings.
- 4. Recently, there have also been cases of two or a group of people going door-to-door to report good news.5. Besides, their methods will continue to evolve one after another. Therefore, we call on our church brothers and sisters to be cautious and avoid entering into cults/heretical groups. If you encounter any of the above situations and need assistance, please inform your cell group leader/parents or contact the church's pastoral staff.

It's Good To Be Alive

Ps Caleb Soo

Introduction: Why do we say, "It's good to be alive"?

Because the one lying in the coffin is not me.

The Bible says, "For a living dog is better than a dead lion." (Ecclesiastes 9:4) In short, as long as a person is still alive, they should cherish life and be thankful.

1) It's good to be alive, because there is life.

Be thankful for being able to live to this age. $65 \times 365 = 23,725$ days; $80 \times 365 = 29,200$ days.

Countless people have lost their lives in natural disasters and human tragedies; many have died from illness, sudden collapse, or unexplained causes.

At the same time, to live with a heart of gratitude, we must take care of our bodies.

According to medical advice, if we maintain the following five habits not smoking, keeping a healthy weight, eating a balanced diet, exercising, and controlling alcohol intake—

we can greatly reduce the risk of many illnesses, including an 82% lower chance of cardiovascular disease and a 90% prevention rate for diabetes.

On the other hand, we must watch our emotions, because emotions can "hurt the heart." No wonder the Bible says,

"A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones." (Proverbs 17:22)

In short, do not suppress emotions for long periods, as this can lead to a distorted personality—such as irritability, indifference, isolation, binge eating, alcoholism, and other obsessive traits—while positive traits like friendliness, trust, and diligence may fade, leading to strained relationships.

As we grow older, learning to let go and keep a pure heart becomes especially important—stop comparing yourself to others, and stop holding grudges.

Lastly, poor eating habits can also "hurt the heart." The key is less sugar, less salt, and less oil, focusing on the quality of food rather than the quantity.

Good health allows us to enjoy a quality life in our later years and to truly feel the happiness of being alive. Therefore, we must take responsible care of our bodies, which are the "temple of the Holy Spirit."

2) It's good to be alive, because there is love.

We are grateful that our daily needs—food, clothing, shelter, and transportation—are more than sufficient.

According to United Nations statistics, more than 700 million people in the world live on less than USD \$1.90 a day. Not only do we have enough, but we can also enjoy what we possess.

Furthermore, it's good to be alive because we are created in the image of God.

Human beings are precious—endowed with thought, wisdom, and morality. That's why a philosopher once said,

"I would rather be a suffering human than a happy pig."

Therefore, life is good because we can live out God's image—a life of love.

Be like the life-filled Mediterranean Sea, not like the lifeless Dead Sea.

To give and to bless.

The Bible clearly says, "It is more blessed to give than to receive" and "Bless and do not curse."

When we walk according to God's Word, blessings will come to us in an unending flow.

To become like a river of living water, our lives must keep flowing.

What blessings does giving bring?

First, it builds harmony and closeness between people, increasing mutual trust and unity, and gaining the blessing of being well-liked.

Try blessing the people around you—your co-workers, classmates, neighbors, relatives, helpers, employers, brothers and sisters in Christ, and so on.

You will find that they become more endearing, and they will like you and draw closer to you, because everyone longs to be blessed.

Second, helping others allows us to experience our own value and purpose.

It fills our hearts with satisfaction and joy, especially when we see others rise out of difficulty and become better because of our help.

In short, the more a person gives, the more they become like the Lord who called them.

On the other hand, those who curse others are often trapped by their own negative emotions—such as anger, anxiety, and guilt.

These emotions, in turn, damage their own image, causing others to see them as immature and unkind.

To give and to forgive.

The Bible tells us to "forget what is behind," and this includes forgetting the faults of others.

If we keep "replaying" someone's mistakes or the hurt they caused us, it will only bring greater harm to our spiritual life and emotional well-being.

Martin Luther King Jr. said, "An eye for an eye leaves both people blind in the end."

Holding on to hatred and seeking revenge—wanting the other person to suffer—will only make us suffer too.

On the other hand, forgiving others is like forgiving ourselves; it sets us free.

The love that forgives comes from God—using God's forgiveness to forgive ourselves, and His acceptance of us to accept ourselves.

Those who have experienced God's forgiveness and acceptance can forgive themselves and others.

You may collect stamps, old banknotes, or ancient coins—but never collect resentment or discontent.

3) It's good to be alive, because there is hope.

Avoid Falling Into The Temptation of Lust

1 Corinthians 6:15-20; Hebrews 13:4

Introduction:

Paul wants believers to understand that our bodies were redeemed at a great price by Jesus Christ and have become the "temple of the Holy Spirit". Therefore, we must keep our bodies pure, avoid sexual immorality, and honor God with our bodies, living a life that is set apart and holy.

All the more, after a man and woman are married, it means that their bodies belong to each other. Therefore, neither has the right to misuse their own body by engaging in sexual relations with a third party.

When either spouse commits adultery, it is not only a sin against the other person, but also a sin against God. This is one of the main causes of the breakdown of a marriage. Be extremely cautious.

Today, our main focus is this: as someone who belongs to the Lord and is in a marital relationship, how can we avoid falling into the temptation of lust? Even if you are not married, you still need to guard yourself against the temptation of lust.

 Recognize that our generation is extremely open toward sex, and acknowledge that we are highly exposed to sexual temptations. Therefore, we must make a firm commitment from the start to uphold holiness. This includes: Not forming inappropriate intimate relationships with anyone; Avoiding viewing online content that promotes immoral or unnatural sexual behavior; steering clear of situations where you are alone with someone of the opposite sex.

Do not allow unhealthy or inappropriate romantic feelings to develop, in order to avoid falling into the three-step trap of sexual temptation:

- a) Attraction and interaction stage
- b) Sexual fantasy stage
- c) Matured stage

Modern science and psychology have studied that the attraction between people is often related to subtle signals emitted from our bodies. These signals may come in the form of a scent or a kind of electromagnetic-like sensation.

- 2. Strive to build a healthy marriage. A harmonious relationship with your spouse is one of the best defenses against infidelity. This involves maintaining regular communication, sharing household responsibilities, travel together, and cultivating a healthy sex life.
 Do not try to change each other, but instead learn to accept one another in love. You got married because of love, and now that you are married, you must continue to love.
- 3. View each other within the broader context of relationships. How can we avoid having sexual thoughts toward someone of the opposite sex? By remembering the people connected to them—when you see him or her, think also of their spouse, children, and parents. To sin against them is to sin against all those connected to them. It not only defiles yourself, but also brings dishonor to your own spouse, children, and parents. Learn from the Puritans by treating the family as a "little church" where love and mutual care are cultivated.
- 4. Stay connected to church fellowship. Predators often target animals that are isolated from the group. Similarly, one key purpose of fellowship is mutual encouragement and spiritual protection.
- 5. Finally, remember that the consequences of sin can be devastating.

 As one Christian leader who was forced to resign due to sexual immorality once said:

"If I had truly known and thought about the price my actions would cost—myself, my family, and my Lord—I believe I absolutely, absolutely would not have done it."

Conclusion:

When it comes to matters of lust, never assume you are immune to falling. Instead, stay vigilant and give no foothold to the devil, for he prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour (1 Peter 5:8; Ephesians 4:27). Rather, "submit yourselves to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you." (James 4:7)

By guarding the purity of marriage with such diligence, we honor what Scripture teaches:

"Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterers." (Hebrews 13:4)
